John 14:6 MSG*

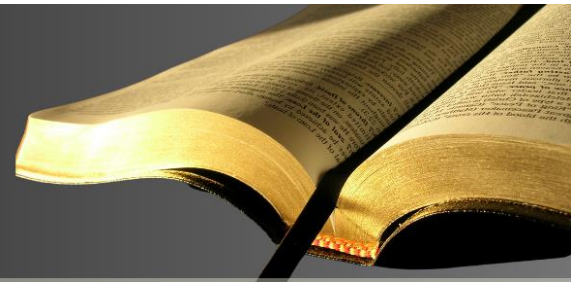
The good news of great joy for this season is this:

# CREATED FOR DOMINION

*27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. 28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth. 29 And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which is upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which is the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat. GEN1:27-29KJV*

Have you ever wondered why this world was created? Or more importantly, why you were created to live in the world with everything that is in the world?

The first and most important step towards the right use of a thing is knowledge of its purpose. To be right about it, we must first know why it exists. This is true for man, the world and everything in the world.

Dr. Myles Munroe said it so well: "When the purpose of a thing is unknown, abuse is inevitable." You can never be right about it if you do not know what it was made for. If you do not know why it was made, how can you possibly use it rightly? If you are not using it rightly, you are definitely abusing it. If you abuse it long enough, you will eventually lose it or become lost in it. This is why it is so important for man to focus first on understanding the purpose of man and the things that are connected to man in this world.

## I am made for dominion over all the earth

**So what is the purpose of man and the world in which he lives?**

Without a doubt, the word of God is the source of truth that endures. From, the above passage of scripture, it is clear that God created man in his own image to have dominion over the earth and everything in it. This means that man was created for dominion and everything else in the world was created to be subject to man. God made this fact very clear in the following verse: *29 And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which is upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which is the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat. GEN1:29KJV*

Agreed, not every herb, tree or fruits may be right for you; depending on their usefulness and your taste. However, the truth remains that man was created for dominion. Plants and animals, herbs and trees as well as their seeds and fruits were not created to dominate man but to serve as food for man.

## Plants and animals were created for my food

Of course, man is responsible for cultivating the ground and taking care of all that God has given him as resources for food. Nonetheless, man's responsibility to cultivate and care for God's creation **must never be mistaken for worship**. To do so is to make idols of the creation and make light of the Creator. Worship is a sacred honour to God and God is not very pleased when the sacred worship that is due to Him is given to false gods and idols. He said: *"You must not have any other god but me."* *4 "You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind or an image of anything in the heavens or on the earth or in the sea. EXOD20:3-4NLT* More than that, worship is a spiritual thing that flows only from the spirit of man to God because only man was made in the image of God who is a Spirit. Plants and animals were not created to worship God or receive worship from man as they have no spirit.

This truth about worship and the supremacy of God over all creation is the idea behind the wonderful message and ministry of reconciliation: That God has reconciled the world to Himself through Christ and has given us the ministry of reconciliation. When it says "God has reconciled the world to Himself", it is clear that man is the object of reconciliation in the world. Jesus Christ did not come to the world to reconcile plants, animals, herbs, stones, water and other natural elements of the world to Himself; He came to reconcile man to Himself. It should go without saying that Jesus Christ did not shed His blood on the cross for plants, animals, climate and other inanimate objects of this world. Christ died and rose again for man whom He made in His own image. Christ is supreme over all things. All things are created by Christ for Christ's glory and honour.

## All that I am and have, were made by him for him

By reconciling man to Himself, God restored man's dominion over the earth. With Christ as Head, God placed all things under the dominion of the church. It pleased God to put man in charge of all that he has created. Through faith in Christ and by the help of the Spirit, we are empowered to exercise our dominion over all that God has freely given us to enjoy.

**How can we apply this truth to our everyday life this week?**

- [1] Believe that you were made for dominion.** Our best worship to God is made from our position of restored glory and excellence and not from shame and reproach. To relegate himself to a worshipper of plants and animals is for man to demonstrate lack of knowledge of His Creator who made him for dominion over the earth. If it is worth giving to God it must be authentic and without blemish
- [2] Refuse to become a slave to things.** It is impossible to serve God and things with the same level of devotion. The older brother of the prodigal son learnt this lesson rather late. He was slaving in the field thinking his attitude of servitude will please his father until he discovered late that his father wanted was a son and not a slave to things. God has given us all things to enjoy so that we can worship him from the position of glory and honour.
- [3] Shine where you are.** The antidote to being dominated is to shine where you are. We live in a world of overwhelming flood of belief systems. The only way to survive is to build confidence in the light of God's word and shine wherever we are. The word is light. Light will always dominate darkness. Darkness can never dominate light. No matter how dark it is, light will always dominate. Light shines by nature.

# WORD MEDITATION - WEEK 2416

## SCRIPTURE READING KJV, NKJV, AMP, NLT, MSG, GNT, TLB

### JOHN 3

<sup>16</sup>For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. <sup>17</sup>For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. <sup>18</sup>Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. <sup>19</sup>This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil.

### COL 1

<sup>15</sup>The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. <sup>16</sup>For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. <sup>17</sup>He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. <sup>18</sup>And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy. <sup>19</sup>For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, <sup>20</sup>and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.

<sup>21</sup>Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of <sup>[a]</sup>your evil behavior. <sup>22</sup>But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation— <sup>23</sup>if you continue in your faith, established and firm, and do not move from the hope held out in the gospel. This is the gospel that you heard and that has been proclaimed to every creature under heaven, and of which I, Paul, have become a servant.

### 2COR 5

<sup>17</sup>Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: <sup>[a]</sup>The old has gone, the new is here! <sup>18</sup>All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: <sup>19</sup>that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. <sup>20</sup>We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. <sup>21</sup>God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

### ACTS 17

<sup>21</sup>(All the Athenians and the foreigners who lived there spent their time doing nothing but talking about and listening to the latest ideas.)

<sup>22</sup>Paul then stood up in the meeting of the Areopagus and said: "People of Athens! I see that in every way you are very religious. <sup>23</sup>For as I walked around and looked carefully at your objects of worship, I even found an altar with this inscription: to an unknown god. So you are ignorant of the very thing you worship—and this is what I am going to proclaim to you.

<sup>24</sup>"The God who made the world and everything in it is the Lord of heaven and earth and does not live in temples built by human hands. <sup>25</sup>And he is not served by human hands, as if he needed anything. Rather, he himself gives everyone life and breath and everything else.

<sup>26</sup>From one man he made all the nations, that they should inhabit the whole earth; and he marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands. <sup>27</sup>God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from any one of us. <sup>28</sup>"For in him we live and move and have our being." <sup>[a]</sup>As some of your own poets have said, "We are his offspring." <sup>[a]</sup>

<sup>29</sup>"Therefore since we are God's offspring, we should not think that the divine being is like gold or silver or stone—an image made by human design and skill. <sup>30</sup>In the past God overlooked such ignorance, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent. <sup>31</sup>For he has set a day when he will judge the world with justice by the man he has appointed. He has given proof of this to everyone by raising him from the dead."

### MATT 6

<sup>19</sup>"Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. <sup>20</sup>But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. <sup>21</sup>For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

<sup>22</sup>"The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are healthy, <sup>[a]</sup>your whole body will be full of light. <sup>23</sup>But if your eyes are unhealthy, <sup>[a]</sup>your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light within you is darkness, how great is that darkness!

<sup>24</sup>"No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.
