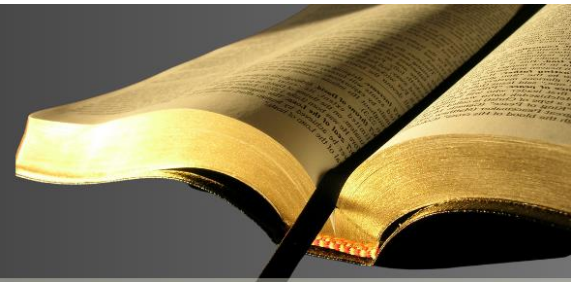

## THE WORD IN YOUR HEART AND MOUTH

**ROMANS 8:10** <sup>8</sup> But what does it say? *"The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach):* <sup>9</sup> that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." NKJV

Everything begins with a seed. Creation began with a seed. Human lives are products of seeds. Health, healing, wellness, prosperity, peace and life are seeds and so are sickness, poverty, war and death,

The Seed for creating, revealing and manifesting the life of God is the word of God. The Word created all things. The Word upholds all things. The Word reveals all things. The seed is the WORD.

Like every other seed, the word of God produces results only when it is planted in a good soil and cared for. The soil for the seed of the word is the heart. You can see why God says to guard our hearts with all diligence for out of it flows the issues of life. The seed we plant in our hearts determines the fruits we see in our lives.

**Luke 8:11-15 NKJV** <sup>11</sup> "Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. <sup>12</sup> Those by the wayside are the ones who hear; then the devil comes and takes away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. <sup>13</sup> But the ones on the rock are those who, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, who believe for a while and in time of temptation fall away. <sup>14</sup> Now the ones that fell among thorns are those who, when they have heard, go out and are choked with cares, riches, and pleasures of life, and bring no fruit to maturity. <sup>15</sup> But the ones that fell on the good ground are those who, having heard the word with a noble and good heart, keep it and bear fruit with patience.

The seed is the Word of God. We plant the seed of the Word by hearing, reading and speaking the word. The Word we put in our hearts will come out through our mouths into our lives and our world. The word in our hearts shapes our thoughts, words and actions. So, it is not enough to read, hear and speak the word; we must plant the word in our hearts and cultivate it.

The word we plant in the head is like the seed planted by the wayside, it will soon fly away. The word we smear on our lips is like the seed planted on stony grounds, it has no roots. The word we store in our minds is like the seed planted among thorns it will be choked and forgotten when the winds of life blow. Only the seed of the word that is planted in the heart produces results and a harvest of joyful testimonies.

The way to plant and cultivate the seed of the Word in our hearts is by delighting, meditating, doing and speaking the word to ourselves and others. It is impossible to meditate in the word wholeheartedly and not make visible progress. Our progress must show in our words and actions. The beautiful thing about the word in our mouths and hearts is that it accomplishes what we say and releases a powerful anointing to others when we share the word of God from the abundance of it in our hearts.

## What is the **WORD** in your heart and mouth?

**COL 3:16-17 NKJV** <sup>16</sup> Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. <sup>17</sup> And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

# WORD MEDITATION - WEEK 2417



## SCRIPTURE READING KJV, NKJV, AMP, NLT, MSG, GNT, TLB

### MARK11

<sup>22</sup> So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God. <sup>23</sup> For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. <sup>24</sup> Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive *them*, and you will have *them*."

### ROMANS10

<sup>6</sup> But the righteousness of faith speaks in this way, "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?' " (that is, to bring Christ down *from above*) <sup>7</sup> or, " 'Who will descend into the abyss?' " (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). <sup>8</sup> But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach): <sup>9</sup> that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

<sup>11</sup> For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame." <sup>12</sup> For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. <sup>13</sup> For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

<sup>14</sup> How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? <sup>15</sup> And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written:

"How beautiful are the feet of those who <sup>[b]</sup>preach the gospel of peace,  
Who bring glad tidings of good things!"

<sup>16</sup> But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our report?" <sup>17</sup> So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

### LUKE8

<sup>4</sup> And when a great multitude had gathered, and they had come to Him from every city, He spoke by a parable: <sup>5</sup> "A sower went out to sow his seed. And as he sowed, some fell by the wayside; and it was trampled down, and the birds of the air devoured it. <sup>6</sup> Some fell on rock; and as soon as it sprang up, it withered away because it lacked moisture. <sup>7</sup> And some fell among thorns, and the thorns sprang up with it and choked it. <sup>8</sup> But others fell on good ground, sprang up, and yielded <sup>[e]</sup>a crop a hundredfold." When He had said these things He cried, "He who has ears to hear, let him hear!"

<sup>9</sup> Then His disciples asked Him, saying, "What does this parable mean?"

<sup>10</sup> And He said, "To you it has been given to know the <sup>[f]</sup>mysteries of the kingdom of God, but to the rest *it is given* in parables, that

'Seeing they may not see,  
And hearing they may not understand.'

<sup>11</sup> "Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.

<sup>12</sup> Those by the wayside are the ones who hear; then the devil comes and takes away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.

<sup>13</sup> But the ones on the rock *are those* who, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, who believe for a while and in time of <sup>[g]</sup>temptation fall away.

<sup>14</sup> Now the ones *that* fell among thorns are those who, when they have heard, go out and are choked with cares, riches, and pleasures of life, and bring no fruit to maturity.

<sup>15</sup> But the ones *that* fell on the good ground are those who, having heard the word with a noble and good heart, keep *it* and bear fruit with patience.<sup>[h]</sup>

<sup>16</sup> "No one, when he has lit a lamp, covers it with a vessel or puts *it* under a bed, but sets *it* on a lampstand, that those who enter may see the light. <sup>17</sup> For nothing is secret that will not be revealed, nor *anything* hidden that will not be known and come to light. <sup>18</sup> Therefore take heed how you hear. For whoever has, to him *more* will be given; and whoever does not have, even what he <sup>[i]</sup>seems to have will be taken from him."
